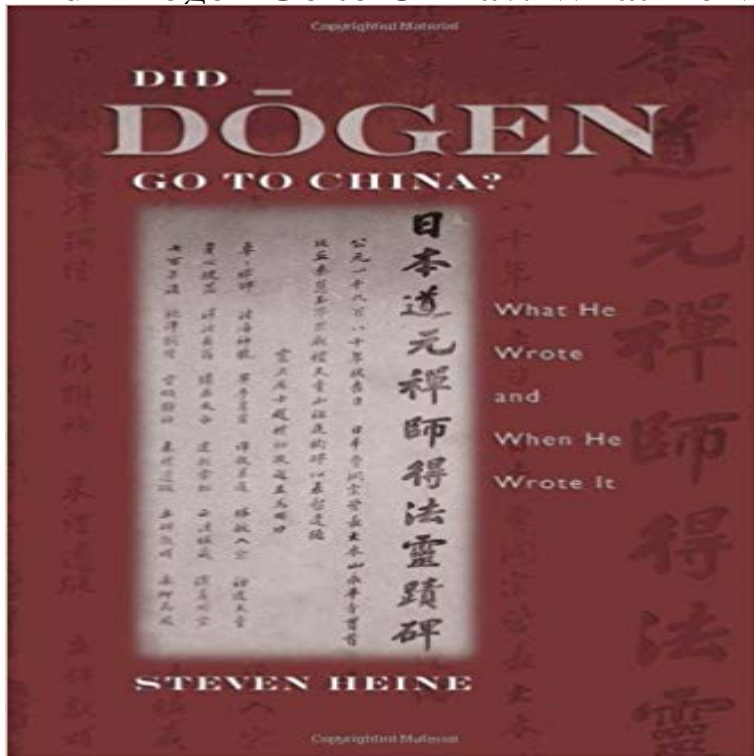


# Did D=ogen Go to China?: What He Wrote and When He Wrote It
