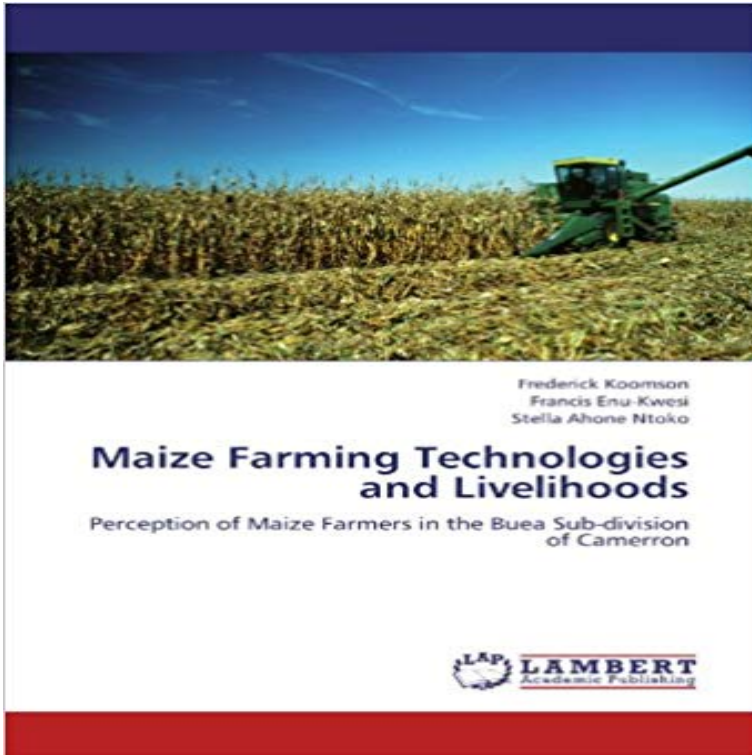


Maize Farming Technologies and Livelihoods: Perception of Maize Farmers in the Buea Sub-division of Cameroon
