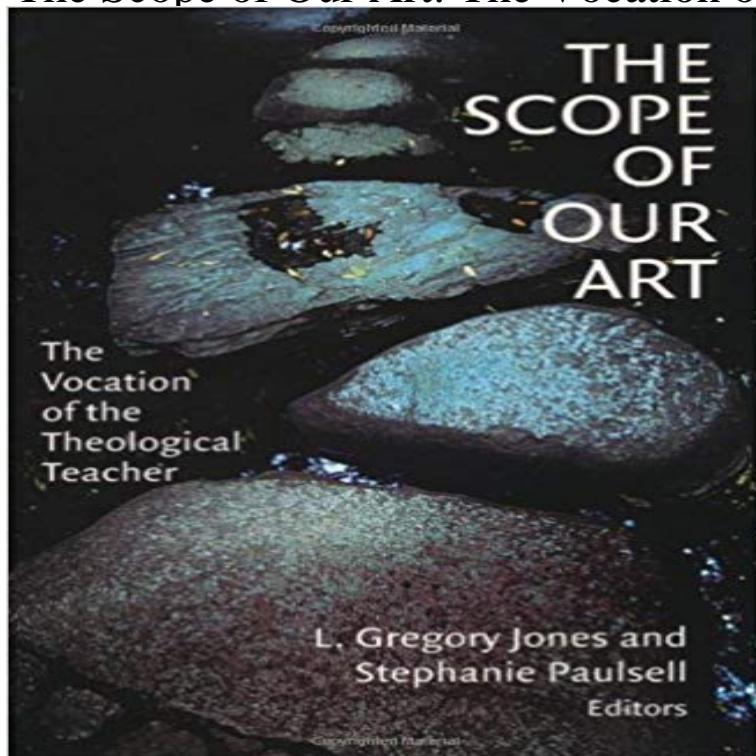


The Scope of Our Art: The Vocation of the Theological Teacher
